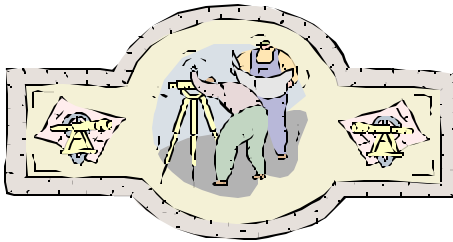

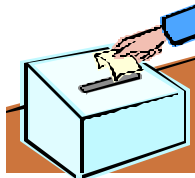

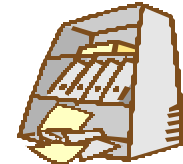


There are plans for **more** exciting enhancements to your library experience:
